- ◆ Upon death, your relatives contact the funeral home and pay for services directly
- ◆ Pre-payment is not necessary
- ◆ If death occurs out of town, contact the national FCA office (1-800-765-0107) to find a nearby alliance office,
- ◆ If you move, you may transfer your membership to another chapter.

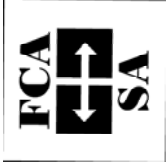

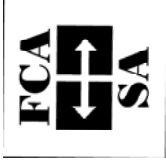
